

Former Blue Circle Sports Ground, Bromley Common – London Borough of Bromley



Asprey Homes have submitted a planning application to build 788 dwellings on the Former Blue Circle Sports Ground and adjoining land (corner of Bromley Common and Crown Lane), which is entirely within the Green Belt. The response to previous applications to develop this site has been that *“the loss of this vulnerable site would do harm to the concept of the Green Belt in general. This is a significant strategic objection”*.

The proposed development is in conflict with PPG2, The London Plan and London Borough of Bromley’s UDP, and would also have an environmental impact with the loss of hedgerows and the loss of habitat for threatened species such as the dormouse and the great crested newt.

The proposal is currently being considered by the Planning Inspectorate. Representations are invited before 7th June 2007.
