

Entrants must email photographs as attachments to competition@cprelondon.org.uk and include the following information:

- Photographer's name
- Address
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Location of photo
- Date photo taken
- Name of photograph or caption (no more than 20 words)
- 1. Photographs should be taken either in one of the 32 boroughs covered by the Greater London Authority or in the City of London.
- 2. You do not have to be a resident of either a London Borough or the City of London to enter.
- 3. You need to be aged 16 or over to take part in the competition.
- 4. We can only accept digital images.
- 5. Images should be in jpeg. format and have a minimum file size of 1Mb, and maximum 10Mb. Please do not send any emails with total attachments over 10Mb.
- 6. CPRE London will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged entries.
- 7. Photographers will retain copyright for their work, however the registered charities CPRE and CPRE London will have the ongoing right to exhibit and use images in print and online for purposes of promoting their charitable works.
- 8. Photographers will always be accredited in any use of the images.
- 9. Entrants must have obtained permission of any person or persons who are clearly featured in the entries (or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured) on the understanding that the image can be used in accordance with point number 7 in these Terms and Conditions of entry.
- 10. We will take appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial measures to ensure we keep your information secure. We will not share your data with any third-party organisation.
- All personal information provided in relation to the competition will be treated in accordance with our privacy policy details of which can be found on our website at https://www.cprelondon.org.uk/
- 12. The closing date of the competition is Friday 18th September. Entries must reach us by midday on Friday 18th September.
- 13. The photographs will be judged by our panel, Derek Man, Kate Jones and Shirley Rodrigues and their decision will be final.
- 14. Judging will be based on a single image and not a series of images.
- 15. The winning and two runner-up entries will be announced on Thursday 8th October 2020.
- 16. The winning entry will receive a cash prize of £150 plus free membership to CPRE London for a year
- 17. There will be two runners-up who will each receive a cash prizes of £50 each plus free membership to CPRE London for a year.
- 18. Submission of a photograph for the competition is taken as an agreement to abide by the above rules.
