Dear Sir,  
Whitewebbs Park.

As the County Council are aware, part of the Municipal Golf Course laid out by my Council has been constructed over the land leased to my Council as playing fields under Section 69 of the Public Health Act, 1925, which land is coloured pink on the enclosed plan of the Park. My Council desire that the Byelaws which they propose to make for the Park should apply to this land as well as to the remainder of the Park. They have therefore made application to the Minister of Health under Section 163 of the Local Government Act, 1933, for his consent to the appropriation of the land coloured pink on the plan for the purposes of Section 164 of the Public Health Act, 1875.

It is, of course, my Council's intention to comply with their covenant contained in Clause 3(k) of the Lease.
